### Employee Hepatitis B Vaccine Declination

I understand that, due to my occupational exposure to blood or other potentially infectious materials, I may be at risk of acquiring hepatitis B virus (HBV) infection. I have been given the opportunity to be vaccinated with hepatitis B vaccine at no charge to myself. However, **I decline hepatitis B vaccination at this time.** I understand that by declining this vaccine, I continue to be at risk of acquiring hepatitis B, a serious disease. If, in the future, I continue to have occupational exposure to blood or other potentially infectious materials and I want to be vaccinated with hepatitis B vaccine, I can receive the vaccination series at no charge to me.

To be vaccinated through the Occupational Health Clinic at the Tang Center, I need to:

1. call 642-6891 to set up an appointment, and
2. bring an IOC or Interdepartment Order for \$185 from my department to the first visit.
