ENVIRONMENT, HEALTH & SAFETY – CHEMICAL WASTE OPENING CLOSING DRUMS WITH BUNG WRENCH

TASK	HAZARDS	CONTROLS
1. Removing bung cap with bung wrench.	Hand and finger injury.	Ensure bung wrench is properly engaged before applying pressure. Wear heavy gloves.
	Injuries from pressurized drums.	Do not open bulging drums. Do not lean directly over the drum while opening.
Required Training: Familiarization with this JSA.	Required Personal Protective Equipment (PPE): Steel-toed boots, lab coat or tyvek suit, safety glasses, and cotton or leather gloves
