RECREATIONAL SPORTS - CAL ADVENTURES CUTTING STEEL WIRE

TASK	HAZARDS	CONTROLS
Measure amount needed.	Poking from sharp end of steel wire	Do not unwind steel wire from wire end. Using pliers or a similar tool, bend the end of the wire around about 180 degrees, or cover the end of the wire with something like rubber or duct tape.
	Injuries to others	Be aware of surrounding personnel. Warn others about sharp wire end.
2. Mark steel wire.	None foreseen	
3. Cut steel wire.	Lacerations from cable cutter	See "Using Hand Tools" for more information.
Required Training: Use of the tool used to cut the wire	Required Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Eye protection
