General Precautions: Safety vests or other reflectives must be worn so front and back of body are easily visible to drivers.

TASK	HAZARDS	CONTROLS
1. Control traffic on Centennial Drive.	Not being visible to drivers	Wear safety vests or other reflectives on front and back of the body.
	Encountering road rage	Stay on the side of the street. Face oncoming cars and make eye contact with drivers.
	Not aware of cars	Remain attentive on duty and be cautious of your surroundings.
2. Control traffic in parking lot.	Injuries from approaching moving vehicle	Approach car only after it has completely stopped. Wear closed-toe shoes. Back away from car before car starts moving.
	Not visible to drivers	See above for more information.
	Encountering road rage	See above for more information.
	Not aware of cars	See above for more information.
3. Assisting children to cars.	Not visible to drivers	See above for more information.
	Encountering road rage	See above for more information.
	Not aware of cars	See above for more information.
